FIRE PITS

With summer right around the corner, Council is requesting the cooperation of our residents with respect to fire pits, burning, and permits.

Under our current bylaw, fire pits must have a permit and be inspected prior to use. Some highlights of the bylaw include:

- Have a bottom and four sides or 360* wide
- be COMPLETELY COVERED BY WIRE MESH
- maximum height/depth be 65 cm
- have a fireguard of noncombustible material surround the outdoor fire appliance
- be a minimum of 4 meters from any building and 6 meters from any property line
- not be allowed prior to 11:00 am and extinguished no later than 11:00 pm
- have water source nearby to extinguish fire

The purpose of our fire pit bylaw is to ensure the safety of our residents; to ensure the peaceful enjoyment of property by others, including those with breathing problems such as asthma; and to comply with environmental regulations including the prohibition of the burning of garbage/refuse by individuals due to the release of emissions / toxins. While the bylaw provides for the burning of wood, the intent of a fire pit is **NOT** to be used as a replacement for the landfill. Burning barrels are prohibited.

If your property contains an outdoor fire appliance (other than a bbq), you are requested to contact the village office for a permit application by May 15th, 2012, to avoid violation of Bylaw 4, 2000. Council will act upon violations of the bylaw.

ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW

Dogs and cats are required to be licensed within the Village by February 15th of each year. Council wishes to advise that an amendment to the Animal Control Bylaw was recently passed. Where the cat or dog is under the care of a registered Veterinarian and documentation is provided from the vet citing the dog or cat is not suitable for a rabies vaccination, the owner of the animal is not required to vaccinate the animal.

Please contact the village office for your pet registration application. Please make sure you attach your rabies certificate or letter from vet.

Any animal not registered by May 15, 2012 is subject to violation for non registered animal and will be dealt with accordingly.

The Village of Perdue is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy neighborhood and an excellent community environment. Our citizens expect us to do everything we can in this regard. We know that this can only be achieved through the cooperation of everyone involved.

IT'S TIME TO CLEAN UP THE YARD!

The birds are singing, the grass is growing! Springtime is a time of renewed growth. Give your property the jump start it needs after the winter season by giving your yard a general clean up to remove garbage and debris, overgrown grass and weeds, dead branches, broken appliances, and junked vehicles. Your neighbors will appreciate it! Please trim back your trees that overhang onto the sidewalks and back lanes so that traffic is not impeded.

If you have a junked vehicle on your property please make arrangements to have it removed. A junked vehicle can be described as: Any automobile, tractor, truck, trailer or other vehicle that

i) either:

1) has no valid license plates attached to it; or

2) is in a rusted, wrecked, partly wrecked, dismantled, partly dismantled, inoperative or abandoned condition; and

ii) is located on private land, but that:

1) is easily visible from off the property; and

2) does not form a part of a business enterprise lawfully being operated on that land



If anyone has any questions or wishes to view our Nuisance Bylaw, please stop in at the Village Office.

Do you require a Building Permit?

Building permits are required for most new construction projects and renovations to existing buildings or land. This includes decks, garages and sheds, even if they are being moved in. These permits ensure that your project will comply with the municipal Zoning Bylaw and the National Building Code.
