NEW ROUND OF NOMINATIONS FOR QUEEN'S DIAMOND JUBILEE MEDALS ANNOUNCED

The Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal was created to mark the 2012 celebrations of the 60th anniversary of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II's accession to the Throne as Queen of Canada. A second round of Nominations is now open. Residents are encouraged to nominate a deserving individual to honor significant contributions and achievements within our community by local residents.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for this honor, a person must:

- Be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada but not necessarily reside in Canada;
- Have made a significant contribution to our community; and
- Be alive on February 6th, 2012, the 60th anniversary of Her Majesty's accession to the Throne. The medal can be awarded posthumously, as long as the recipient was alive on that date.

Nomination forms are available at the Village office and will be accepted at the Village Office until November 15.
