Mark your calendar for municipal elections, October 24 ... Urban municipalities in the province will be holding municipal elections. All eligible residents are encouraged to exercise their civic right by casting a vote in the election for Mayor and Council.

With your vote, you are helping to define the future and leadership of our community.



Call for Nominations

The Call for Nominations is now. Have you ever considered running for municipal office? The Village of Perdue encourages eligible residents who are interested in running for Council or Mayor to consider putting their names forward for election. Elected officials are responsible for the development of public policy and decisions affecting the day to day affairs of their municipality. Members of council have a duty to represent the public and to consider the well-being and interests of the municipality. Nominations are now open and close on September 19. Stop by the Village Office to obtain a Nomination Form and return the completed form by 4:00 pm September 19. Positions are 4 year terms and Council consists of Mayor and 4 (four)

Who Can Vote?

Eligible voters must be:

- at least 18 years old on Election Day; a Canadian citizen; a resident of Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day; and either: a) a resident of the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election: or; b) an owner of assessable land for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election.

The polling station will be located at the Perdue Rec Complex and will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. **An advance poll, located at the Perdue Rec Complex will be open October 15, from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.** You may vote at an Advance Poll if you: are disabled; are an election official; or have reason to believe you will be absent from your residence and poll on Election Day.

Voter ID Now Required

Voter ID will be required for this election. Acceptable Voter ID includes: Photo identification is ID that is **government-issued, valid** and has your **photo, name and address**. If your identification does not meet these criteria it will not be recognized as an acceptable form of photo identification. Examples include: A valid

Saskatchewan Driver's License, any other valid **government issued photo ID** issued by a Canadian government whether federal, provincial or municipal, or an agency of that government, **so long as** it includes your **name and address**. If you do not currently have photo identification you can acquire non-drivers photo-ID from SGI. A complete list of acceptable identification is available at the Village Office.

If you don't have photo ID and are unable to obtain photo-ID before Election Day, you can present **two** other pieces of information, as long as **both contain your name and at least one contains your address**. Examples include: Valid **ID cards or certificates** issued by the Canadian or Saskatchewan government, a Saskatchewan municipality or school division, a Saskatchewan Indian band, the Métis Nation of Sask. or an agency of one of these entities, **Personal** correspondence, benefit/contribution statements and tax/ assessment notices issued by any of the above entities; Bank/credit union cards, credit cards and statements; Utility **bills and statements** issued within six months of the date of the election; **Personalized** attestation of residence, letter of stay or admission form issued by a seniors or student residence, long term care or shelter facility.
